1. The candidate has to visit the study site frequently to collect, identify and preserve plant/animal/microbial samples including preparation of herbarium specimens/ spirit collections. He/she has to make data compilation, analysis and report writing. In addition to the above, the JPFs can be assigned any other relevant work by the Chairman/ Member Secretary of Odisha Biodiversity Board.
2. The above posts are purely temporary and co-terminus with the project. The engagement/ appointment of candidates shall stand terminated automatically after expiry of the project or completion of period indicated in the office order, whichever is earlier. The JPF will have no claim for further temporary or permanent employment in Odisha Biodiversity Board or in the State Government.
3. Member Secretary, as his discretion, may increase or decrease the number of positions and also to cancel recruitment process for all the above positions without assigning any reason thereof. The decision of the Member Secretary is final and binding on all research fellows and projects.
4. Candidates can apply for multiple projects and may be considered for projects which he/she has not applied in the application form. The decision of the Member Secretary will be final in this matter with the willingness of candidates.
5. No TA/DA is admissible for attending the interview.
6. Canvassing in any form will render the candidate disqualified for the position.
7. A panel will be prepared by the selection committee separately for each project. Whenever required, candidates will be engaged for different activities.
8. The interview may be conducted over two days if the number candidates increases beyond 100.
